General Information Architect would like to get varied colors - a sort of a rainbow of related colors, with blue and violet emphasized in the lower, going up through red, orange and yellow in the upper ones.

Lettering - a two-word name, in the upper part of each one, and leave a space for this - light on dark, so he can put in the names when he gets them.

The glass openings are  $1'3\frac{1}{4}$  inches wide by  $9\frac{1}{4}$ " high. There are four above each other, with about 8 inches between.

This is a large room - and they would like full brilliant color. To be an abstract design, with floral accents and a minimum of drawing.

Our thought is to suggest the Descent of Divine Light, transformed by the prism of Life into the spectrum or rainbow of Hope and Promise.

The basic pattern is accented with the Lamp of Enlightenment; the Lily of Purity; the Rose of Love; and, in the lower panel, the Open Book of Learning.

We have indicated names in color to suggest how the memorials can be included..."
