We have completed our study of the entire group of narthex windows and are sending the rough color sketches herewith.

After the first two devoted to Samuel and David, which you so kindly returned; there are those for Daniel and Jeremiah.

Daniel holds a symbol of the three men in the fiery furnace, with his traditional lions below.

Jeremiah holds the chains of bondage with the broken yoke of his fifth chapter, fifth verse.

Finally, Moses holds the Tablets of the Law, with the burning bush below; and Isaiah bears the tongs with flaming coal with which the angel cleansed his lip, (the Seraphim below).

Of course these can be arranged as you wish, but we have introduced an alternation of color, ruby and blue, with the thought that David and Jeremiah might be the pair on the South side, with Isaich in the West facade toward the South, Samuel and David near the stairs at the Northwest corner, and Moses on the North.
