General Information The pastor thinks all the windows should be kept light windows you can see through - should not become "busy". Dr. Carey says "... glass of a "swirly" kind.

SEE PHOTOGRAPHS AND COLOR PLATES OF WINDOWS IN PLACE.

They are designed in a very light palette and simple but well composed leading. Suggestions of the grapevine and grapes through the fields and border suggest the unity and fruitfulness of the Church, and recall Our Lord's significant words, - "I am the vine, ye are the branches". The principal medallions alternate in cool and warm colors, - blue and ruby.

In the third window, Saint James the Less is symbolized by the windmill, the shield bearing the stones of his martyrdom, and the fuller's bat also in reference to his martyrdom.

The companion panel represents Saint Jude's sail-boat, with the inverted cross, club and lance above, and the boat hook and square below.

The purses are the principal symbol for Saint Matthew, in reference to his original calling, with the halberd above, and his Gospel below.

Saint Thomas is represented by the square, spear and arrows, the leather girdle and three stones, and the scroll inscribed with the significant text, - "My Lord and my God".

Saint Simon has the book upon which lies a fish, - the fisher of men through the power of the Gospel; and again, the fish and boat hook, the ears and battle-axe.

The group is completed with the symbols of Saint Matthias, - the open Bible and a double battle-axe, the sword and lance, and again, three stones.
