General Information

The Rector is interested in a jewel-like window first, and secondly the symbolism, which is to be the Agnus Dei.

As planned, it is devoted to the Agnus Dei, with the Lamb bearing the banner of victory inscribed with the cross.

The surrounding grapevine pattern symbolizes the fruitfulness of the Church, recalling the words of Our Lord, "I am the Vine, ye are the branches".

We feel the deep full color palette will take its place beautifully above the reredos, complementing and enhancing it and the altar below.
