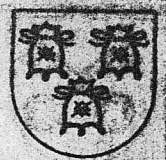
Window on Epistle side to have Seal of St. Alban.

**JAMES (THE LESSER)**

Represented by a saw, since it is said his body was sawn asunder after a horrible martyrdom.



**MATTHEW, AS AN APOSTLE**

Is symbolized by three purses referring to his original calling as a tax collector.



**THOMAS**

A carpenter's square and a spear, because this apostle is said to have built a church with his own hands, in India. Later, he was persecuted there and was killed with a spear by a pagan priest.



**BARTHOLOMEW**

This apostle is said to have been flayed alive, hence he is usually represented by three flaying knives.



**SIMON THE ZEALOT**

This symbol is a book upon which rests a fish, because through the power of the Gospel Simon became a great fisher of men.



**MATTHIAS**

Chosen to take the place of Judas, he is symbolized by an open Bible and double bladed battle-axe. He is said to have been beheaded after his missionary work.



**THE TWELVE APOSTLES**

The apostles have been symbolized as a group as well as individually. In one place, twelve doves are used; in another, twelve men are shown, each with a sheep. Some very early carvings represent the apostles as twelve sheep.

# SYMBOLS OF THE APOSTLES

## PETER

The crossed keys recall Peter's confession and our Lord's gift to him of the keys of the kingdom. See Matt. 16:18, 19.



## ANDREW

Tradition says that while Andrew was preaching in Greece he was put to death on a cross of this type.



## JAMES (THE GREATER)

The scallop shell is the symbol of pilgrimage and stands for this apostle's zeal and missionary spirit.



## JOHN, AS AN APOSTLE

Early writers state that John once drank from a poisoned chalice and was unharmed. Jesus once said that John should drink of His cup.



## PHILIP

A cross and two loaves of bread; because of Philip's remark when Jesus fed the multitude. (John 6:7)



## JUDE

This apostle traveled far on missionary journeys in company with Simon, according to tradition, hence the ship.



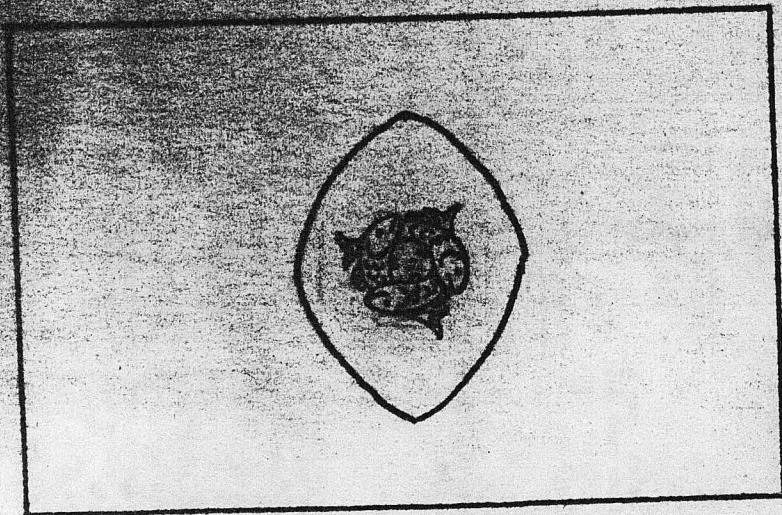

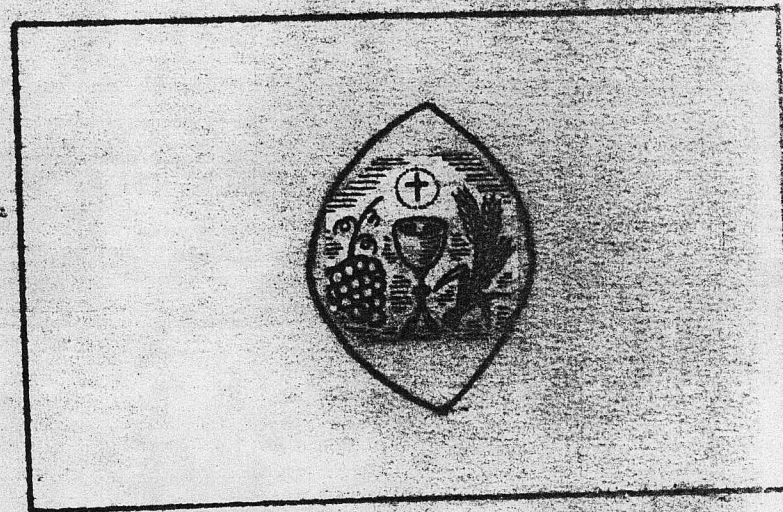

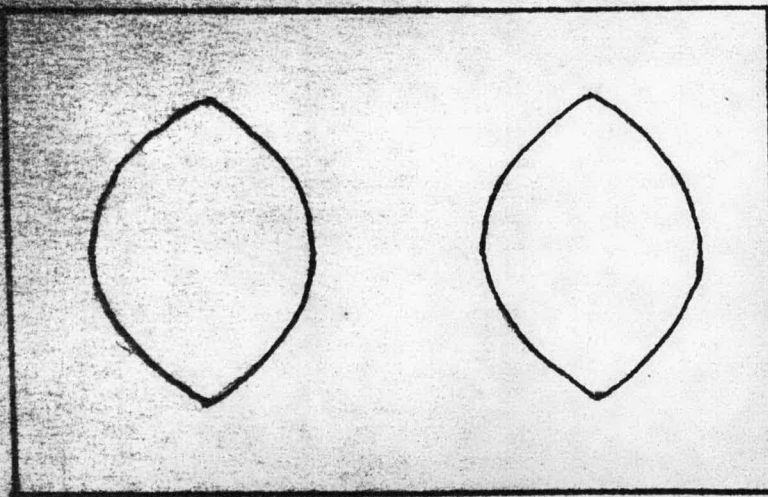

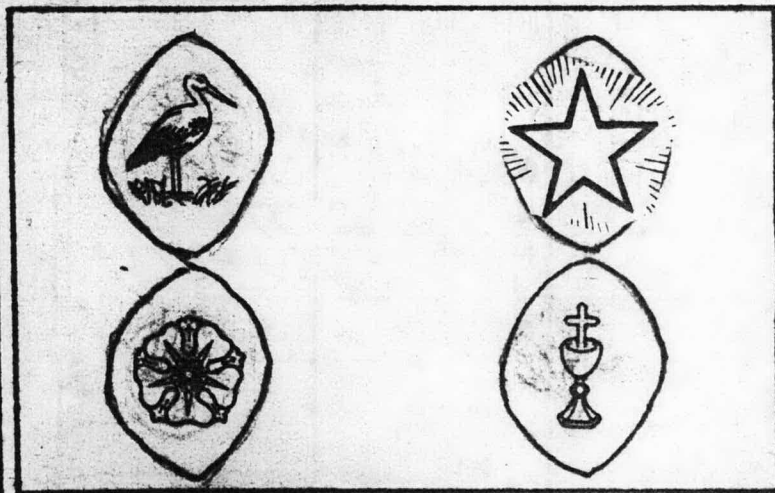

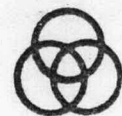


CHANCEL - EPISTLE SIDE  
SEAL OF ST. ALBAN 23" x 46 1/2"

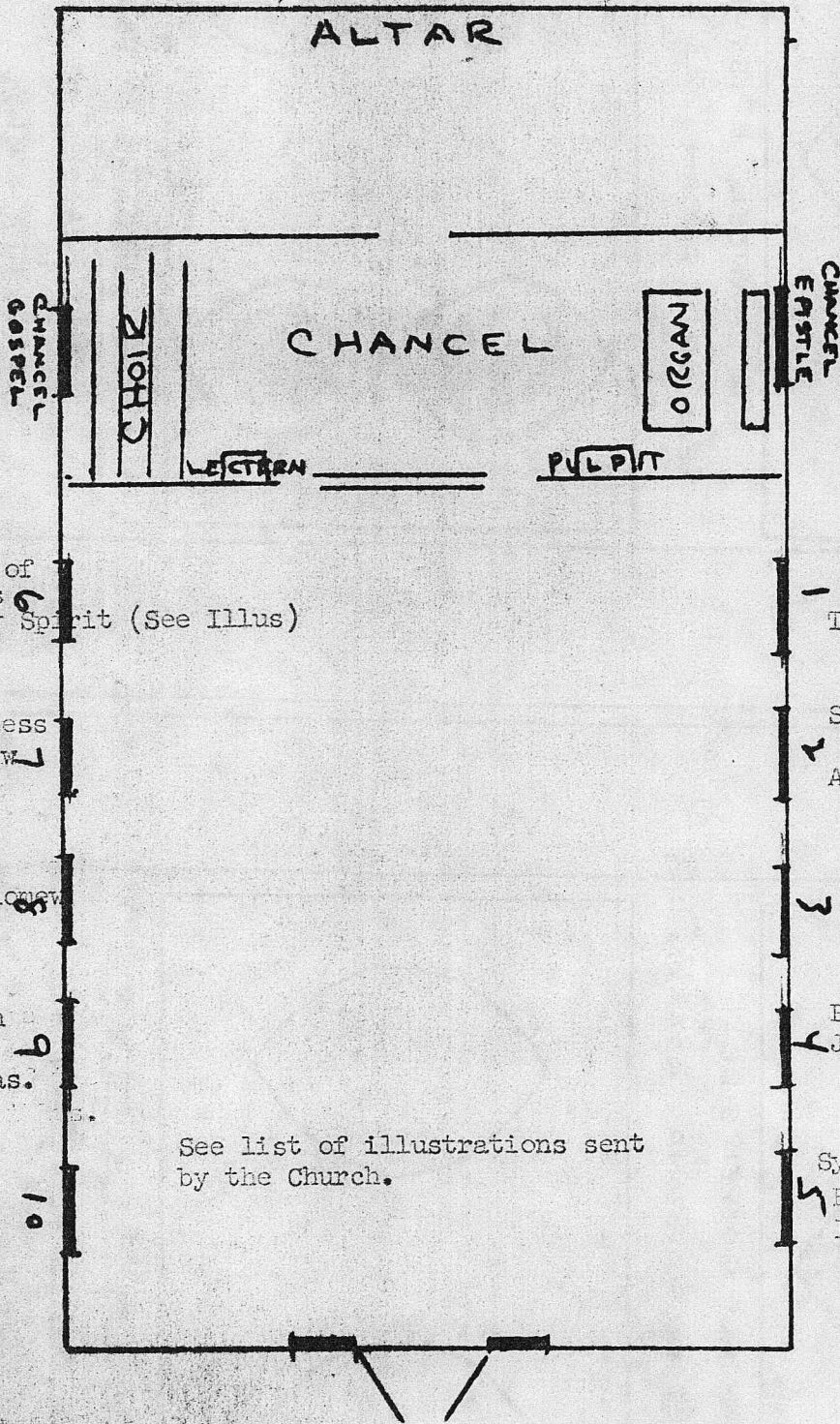


NAVE WINDOWS # 1 and 6 Alternate

The chancel windows would be treated in much the same manner. The more pointed aureole shape could be used if you prefer, but we rather like the oval.

I think we can develop the windows in this manner for seven hundred and twenty-five dollars each, delivered to the church.

Although the chancel windows are somewhat smaller, the involved detail of their seals would keep the cost about the same. The panels beside the door could be a little less, with one significant Christian symbol as the dominant theme in each.

As planned, one is devoted to the Seal of the Diocese. The colors indicated in the print you sent are not very rich. I wonder if we could use clearer and purer tones especially for the blues; and could not the central cross be richer gold?

The other features the shield of Saint Alban. We have added the martyr's crown and scrolls to harmonize with the opposite one. Of course these can be omitted if you prefer.

As we said in our earlier message, we propose to make these first ones for seven hundred dollars each in spite of the complexity of the shields.

To be entirely safe, it would be well to again verify the exact sizes, - the full or actual glass size and the sight or daylight size, with the width and depth of the rebate or groove.
