General Information "Nativity"

Devoted to the Nativity of Our Lord, it is developed in variations of the earlier window, in a manner to maintain an over-all harmony with it. The principal medallion represents Mary and the Child Jesus in the manger; with the traditional ox and ass near by.

In the smaller medallions at the four corners of the lower panel are the three Kings with their gifts, and Joseph.

Above are the shepherds with their sheep, and in the upper medallions, - the heralding Angels. Above all is the Star of Bethlehem. In the intermediate medallions are lilies of Purity where roses of Divine Love were represented in the earlier window.
