Note: Mr. Kennedy has okayed the dome. The plastic is to be the same color as the earlier one, but we have to keep the curve - not make it flat, and use the sizes given on his print; but he is going to inquire to see if the bronze frame comes with the next shipment of marble, which is due soon. If it does it would be a chance to check the sizes from the actual frame.

Frame is at Louis Lualdi's - Trobridge 6-4822. He will send template.

Contract reads: "...furnish and install, in a bronze frame provided by others, a dome light of faceted glass for the Chapel of Our Lady of Czestochowa...The subject of this glass dome light is to be the White Polish Royal Eagle, which shall be fabricated according to sketches and full-size cartoons...approved by this office. The faceted glass shall be set in an epoxy resin emulsion of a selected color, and shall be formed to the radius of the mosaic dome...."
