4926-D Zacharias and Elizabeth both pray for a son, with a symbol  
of the Archangel Gabriel above. Joseph holds his traditional  
flowering staff. Mary is represented with the Christ Child in the  
manger, and John the Baptist, beside the Jordan, has the shell of  
Baptism. ← COMPLETED - Sent 1969. - Done

4926-E - Complete July 1970  
Matthias' usual symbols are the open Book and double battle-  
ax. Simon's are the fish on the book, as the great fisher of men  
through the power of the Gospel. Thomas has the carpenter's square  
and spear, and Philip the Apostle, - the crossed staff, two fish  
and loaves of bread in the basket.

4926-C - Comp - Feb 1970  
John you have. Andrew draws a fisherman's net and near him  
is the usual diagonal Cross. Jude's boat suggests his travels on  
missionary journeys. Matthew has money on a table, suggesting his  
original calling, and Bartholomew's symbols are the three flaying  
knives of his martyrdom.

Back of James Minor is the symbol of the saw, as he stands on  
the tower from which he was thrown. James Major's three scallop  
shells, staff and traveler's gourd are symbols of his pilgrimage.  
Peter is accompanied by the inverted Cross, and keys, and John Mark  
sails to Cyprus.

Mary prays, while Martha is busy with her household chores. Nicodemus' lamp recalls his coming by night to see Jesus. Luke has his Evangelistic pen and book, and the caduceus of the physician legend. Stephen has the martyr's crown and palm; and Paul, the Sword of the Spirit, also symbol of his martyrdom.

4926 G. Barnabas holds the book and staff, while near him is the burning pyre. Philip the Evangelist oversees the distribution of alms to widows. Apollos, - "Mighty in the Scriptures" holds the scroll as teacher and preacher. Dorcas is about to be raised from the dead by Peter (rays of Heavenly light), or she might be sitting up. Lydia sells her purple.

The last two, which we understand are ordered, are on a separate card.

Aquillas works on a Tent. Priscilla is in their house used as a place of Christian assembly. Phoebe with scroll, in charge of persons without civic rights, servant of the Church. Timothy with club, stones, and took; and Eunice, his mother, teaching him.

The Reverend Robert W. Galloway - 2- January 10, 1968

Silvanus in the boat, suggests his association with Paul on his second missionary journey. Titus with the Roman temple at Corinth. Philemon, Paul's wealthy convert (possibly with a bag of money); and finally Onesimus, his runaway slave, with broken chains.
