General Information This window balances a stained glass window now in place directly opposite that is very dark. They would like theirs more luminous and colorful. Considerable light golds in the borders and background, and the medallion devoted to the Nativity, very much like the one in Saint Luke's Church, Denver, occupying most of the space.

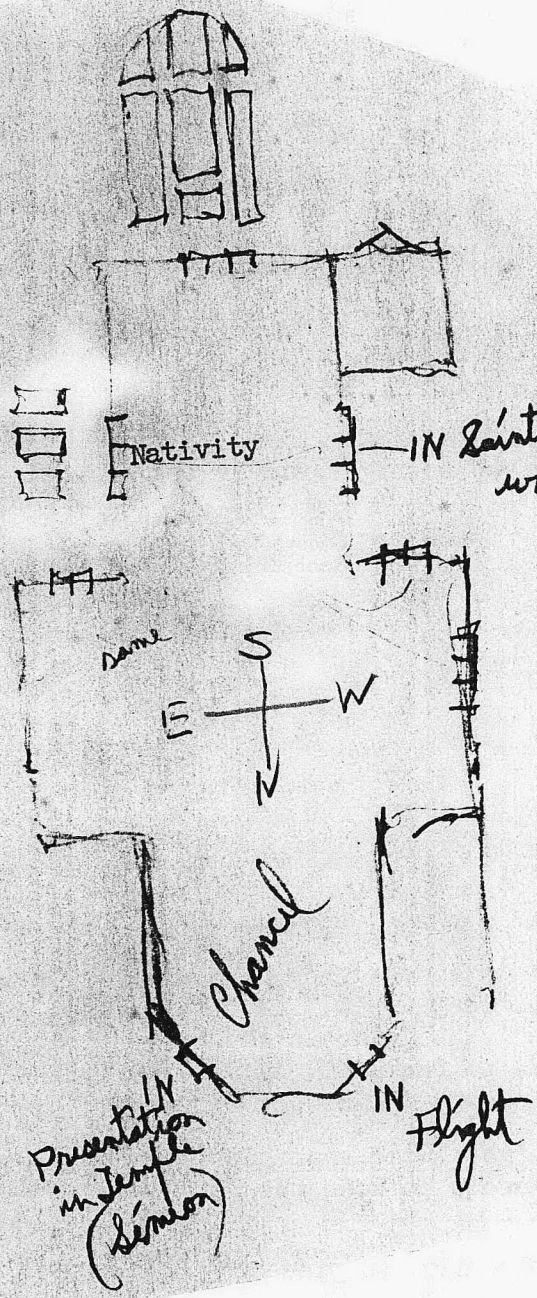
The openings are 20 1/2" x 30 7/8", sight. Wood sash. Set from outside. Probably 3/8" rebate. There are 9 inches between the panels.
