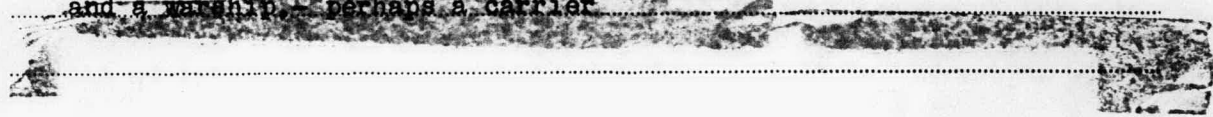

We have pretty closely followed your ideas emphasizing the Biblical theme, both for artistic composition and for its ecclesiastical purpose.

It is designed with considerable freedom of arrangement rather than formal geometric medallions, and will thus harmonize to good purpose with your other windows.

There is the early Greek ship; a clipper ship; Nelson's "Victory"; a modern steamer; and a warship, - perhaps a carrier. These are very roughly suggested here, but will be carefully studied in the actual glass.
