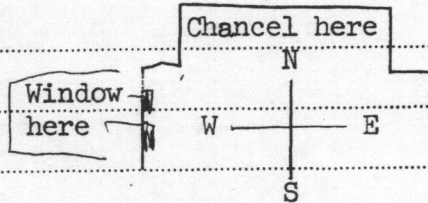

General Information "Gethsemane"

Our designers wanted to study it at once and have prepared a rough color sketch to share with you. This suggests Our Lord kneeling in prayer at the rock, while the three apostles sleep or also kneel in the attitude of prayer.

Rays of divine light descend from the vision of the angel with the cup. The angel could be omitted, having only the cup, or it could be eliminated and the trees extended into the space.

The three crosses of Calvary are suggested in the tracery opening.
