General Information

As planned, it is designed to harmonize with the neighboring window, although in much deeper and richer color.

The dominant symbol is the Cross Potent, also known as the Jerusalem Cross, formed of four Tau crosses resembling ancient crutches meeting at the center. It is the traditional symbol of the Saviour's power to heal the diseases of man's bodies and souls. It is somewhat similar to the Beatitude Cross having eight terminals.

The secondary symbol below is the Lamp of Learning and enlightenment.

A space at the base is provided for the memorial inscription.
