General Information

"As you have the young Christ nearby our thought is to devote these windows to the mature Christ surrounded by His evangelists and apostles.

In the panels at either side of the dominant figure of Our Lord are the four Evangelists, Saints Matthew and Mark, Luke and John, each with pen and book of his Gospel. Below Our Lord is His traditional Chi Rho symbol and Saint Paul, the great missionary.

Through the fields are the symbols of the Apostles, - the fish on the book for Saint Simon, the battle-ax for Saint Matthias, Saint Jude's ship, Saint Bartholomew's scimitar, the shells of Saint James Major, the square and spear for Saint Thomas, Saint Philip's patriarchal cross, Saint Andrew's diagonal cross, the saw for Saint James Minor, and Saint Peter's keys. These, with the figures of Saint John and Saint Matthew, complete the twelve after the addition of Saint Matthias.

The colors are brilliant and luminous to adequately light the stairs.
