General Information..... Samuel and Moses. (Old Testament figures).

Samuel rises from his bed at the call of the Lord symbolized by the Hand of God on the cruciform from which descends rays of heavenly illumination. "Speak Lord for thy servant heareth". In the actual glass I think we can well emphasize Samuel's youth to a greater degree.

Moses kneels and removes his sandals before the burning bush as the Angel of the Lord appears to him out of its midst in a flame of fire.

The decorative architectural "canopy" recalls other windows of the church.

The palette is kept light and brilliant to provide adequate illumination for the vestibule. Possibly we should reverse the figures if we consider the chronological sequence from left to right.

I think we have made too much of the little corner openings which should be smaller.
