General Information

"The Fountain of Life"

**installed in new sash, to be provided and sent to us.

It is our thought to symbolize the Fountain of Life from which drink two harts, receiving Divine refreshment, an ancient and traditional symbol found in many forms throughout Christian art.

The secondary symbols are the Censer of Prayer below, and the Orb surmounted by the Cross above, symbol of Our Lord's domination over the world.

A space is provided at the base for the memorial inscription.

The medallions are of slightly different shapes from the other windows, and the rose pattern, symbol of Divine Love, is suggested through the border instead of the grape. Otherwise the design is quite similar to those now in place.

Of course, the medallions and borders could be just the same if preferred; and other symbols could be used in place of those suggested,- for instance, the Phoenix symbol of Resurrection, the Scales of Justice, the Lamp of Learning and Enlightenment, the Harp of Divine Joy, or the traditional Fish symbol of Our Lord. These would also be fine suggestions for symbols in other windows of the series.
