Letter dated June 1, 1970 rom Mr.Castaldi, who took the sizes.

Herewith is the layout for the two chancel windows for All Saints, Briarcliff.

All the dimensions on the layout are full size.

The ventilators have one bar riveted on as the layout shows. However, the bar can be removed if it interferes with the design. If these bars are to be removed, new bars are to be furnished. These bars should be cut 13" long. The bars for the top section should be cut 15 -1/4" long.

I would recommend that the outside lead on the top section be 3/4" on both sides and 1/2" on the bottom.

The ventilator can have 1/2" outside lead.
