General Information The Nativity

The Blessed Mother of Our Lord kneels beside the manger and the infant Christ Child. Her garment is of light blue; and it seems best to make Her veil white to distinguish it from Her halo which should also be light blue.

Rays of light descend from the Star of Bethlehem toward the Holy Child.

In the background is the small figure of Saint Joseph and the Lily symbol. The white Lily of Purity is repeated through the border.

The Virgin's monogram is designed at the top, with the monograms of Our Lord below.

The traditional Ox and Ass kneels in homage to the new born King symbolized by the Crown.

The text is from Isaiah's ninth Chapter, sixth verse,-
"For unto us a King is born and his name shall be called Wonderful."
