General Information.....

We have developed it with the Rockwell painting before us and have incorporated its character and spirit in the composition. Of course details will be more closely followed in the full size.

Our thought is that all the races of the world are gathered before Our Lord at His Sermon on the Mount when He taught the way of true Christian life and gave us the Beatitudes as a way of brotherly living.

Saint Luke, who recorded the Sermon, is represented in the upper part with his traditional evangelical symbols, - the book and pen, and all look toward Christ, - the church which symbolizes His presence.

Below is the text of the Golden Rule, - "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

Decorative architectural "canopy" above and below harmonizes with other windows.
