General For the Old Testament, Samuel is represented rising from his couch in answer to the Lord's call, - "Speak, for thy servant heareth." A ray of light from Heaven suggests the Divine Blessing. An altar is indicated in the background.

Find The panel for the New Testament represents the young Christ in the Temple at His discussion with the Doctors, - "Both hearing them and asking them questions." The arch above suggests the temple and of Ebeside Him is an open book.

We have in mind using light colored irregular textured glasses that will catch and reflect all available illumination.

We have indicated a little wider panel than you first mentioned. As indicated, they are about 10 inches wide and 24 inches high, but they can be a little narrower if you think best.
