General Information

The design of the west windows is similar in character, with the decorative architectural "canopy". Their relation to the Font suggests representations of Saint John the Baptist and Saint Philip the Deacon, who baptized the Ethiopian. Saint John the Baptist, at the left, is robed in rough skins and holds the traditional crossed staff and symbol of the Lamb of God with cruciform banner. Above are descending rays from the Spirit of the Lord. Below is the Baptism of Our Lord by Saint John.

Saint Philip, in an attitude of teaching, holds the water of baptism. Above is the Angel of the Lord and below his Baptism of the Ethiopian eunuch, whose chariot stands nearby.
