The Corporation of the Massachusetts Institute Of Technology is about to erect a new building for the Chemical Laboratories. It has not funds sufficient to warrant it in making provision for women, other than those now secured to them in the special laboratory. This was provided for advanced students only These provisions are now insufficient for even the advanced students in chemistry who desire instruction, and these students are the only women whom the Institute is pledged to receive.

The only objection now urged by the officers of the Institute to the admission of women to full privileges in all the courses is lack of room in the laboratories and want of suitable accomodations in the building .

There is reason to believe, that if the a sum of money were placed in the hands of the corporation to defray the expenses of such additional accomodations for women as may be deemed by them suitable, a vote of the Board might be secure which would extend all the advantages of the Institute of Technology to women.

If such a vote is taken by the Corporation of the Institute of Tecanology, We the Undersigned ,will pledge ourselves to give, or to obtain , for the purpose named, the sums stated , by the first of June,1882.
