The first item discussed on the agenda was Duplex Input MCD Unit, D-62-1, which included a modification to provide a load unit to the input MCD Unit for the LRI Monitor. Concurrence was reached on this item.

The second item was the LRI Monitor Specifications 6M-3579 (D-77). Concurrence was reached on this specification with modifications to the quantities of signal lines and a change in the source of power. Also the placement of the selection and control switches was changed to provide better operational facilities and greater ease of construction. It is recommended in the concurrence letter that the LRI Monitor Console be air-conditioned.

The next items discussed were the Display Console Specifications for AN/FSQ-7, XD-1 and Production, P-36-2, D-25-5 and the AN/FSQ-7 Auxiliary Console Specifications for XD-1, XD-2, and Production, P-127-2, D-65-5. The main point discussed was the requirements for dimming controls. Agreement on all points was reached but the location of the dimming controls which was to be checked with Sharkey of AFCRC before concurrence.

The proposed concurrence on the Command Post DD Desk design dimensions was carried over until 23 June as IBM was not ready to concur.

Hazeltine is to inform IBM of their acceptance or comments on the proposal for the desk design. MIT has received agreement to the proposal from ADC and is ready to concur.

The switch and label assignments for the Auxiliary Consoles were discussed and it was decided to allocate all day Wednesday 22 June to discussion for concurrence on the documents.
