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Items Concurred (Production)

D-35-3, Changes to the GFI Mapper Counter Frame, was reviewed. The alarm circuits as specified conform with the intent of previous concurred specifications, but MIT would like to review the specifications in D-35-3 regarding alarms in the light of experience gained since the first specification was written. A proposed joint study group will be formed to review these alarms. Concurrence was given with the understanding that this specification clarifies the IBM interpretation of the previous concurred specification, D-35-1.

S-53, Probe System Specification for AN/FSQ-7 and AN/FSQ-8, which makes possible the presentation on an oscilloscope at the maintenance console any waveform available at any probe point in an FSQ-7 or FSQ-8, received concurrence with the final copy incorporating all IBM and MIT corrections and revisions. S-53 revises D-56 and will require Air Force contractual renegotiation for inclusion into each of the sites.

S-14-1, Change to the Program Element Specification, which provides to start test memory address (20, 010 octal) on automatic branch on alarms, received concurrence intact.


Items Discussed

P-265, Testing of the Clock Register Proposal, was dropped. A new proposal will be submitted in the near future after further investigation by IBM.

D-32-4, which gives an audible alarm with each alarm indication, was agreed by IBM and DCO to be retrofitted as a BR change.

The proposal to remove Light Gun Simulators will be given serious consideration by the DCO.
