1. Test Equipment

Taylor inquired how much money would be available for test equipment in fiscal '53. There is no specific test equipment budget. The '53 budget is based on dollars per Staff and should be ample to cover necessary test equipment. The test equipment committee will prepare an estimate of their needs for this year which will be discussed.

2. Whittemore Power

Taylor questioned the proposed method of power distribution for the third floor - it will be discussed with Fahnestock. Forrester emphasized that we must not let the existing standard voltage prejudice the design of Whirlwind II. It was pointed out that many separate supplies now exist and that the design will be independent of previous decisions.

3. Visit of A. G. Hill

Hill will visit us on June 3 to become more familiar with the Whirlwind II plans. Forrester is anxious that we should get all possible help on magnetic materials from Hill's solid state physicists.

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Taylor mentioned that we are now getting good co-operation from Adler on transistors.

4. Reports

Before the issuance of the next Division 3 quarterly report, we should ask Adler for a draft so we can comment on the handling of our part of the work.

Whereas we have had a standard distribution list for all reports of the Transistor Group this will now be discontinued. This does not effect internal distribution of reports. We will want some outside distribution of some transistor reports according to a policy not yet formulated.
