10-1-A Salary Review

Taylor reported meeting in Director's Office today to discuss terms of salary review.

10-22-A Clean-up

Proctor has designated A. Falcione as Division 6 representative for clean-up campaign.

October 29 agenda.

10-22-B Eastern JCC

Brown called attention to the EJCC in New York, December 10, 11, and 12, which will include Lincoln papers on TX-0 by Mitchell and Olsen, and on the cryotron by Buck.

Brown also commented on the Magnetism and Magnetic Materials Conference last week at which Lincoln papers were presented. Taylor stated that a technical seminar for Division 6 is in the planning stage.

10-22-C Budget

Proctor established a deadline for individuals to submit proposals for staff additions and extraordinary budget items; Divisional budget proposals must be in the Director's Office October 25.

10-22-D McGuire Visits

Farr explained the circumstances leading to the decision to discontinue temporarily the visiting trips to McGuire. Discussion explored methods of attaining the objective which is to convey to staff members the urgency and value of their individual efforts in the SAGE air defense task.

Responsibility for organization of McGuire visiting trips has been transferred from Group 66 to Farr's office, which has nearly completed the Lincoln visits to Kingston stemming from Mr. Crago's invitation last spring.

10-22-E Open House

Farr reported that the Open House General Committee is organizing Subcommittees charged with demonstrations, publicity, security, and other phases of the Open House program; each Subcommittee will include a representative from each Division to facilitate interdivisional exchange of ideas.

10-22-F Weapons Integration

Fallows discussed tentative plans for implementing interim capability of BOMARC in SAGE. Taylor explained that the Lincoln action is contingent upon Air Force consolidation of defense authority. Fallows said assistance from equipment groups would be needed within a few months and ops and math specs would be needed by the end of 1957 or early 1958.
