Action

1. Revised Program

Brown stated that the costing study of the revised program is expected to be completed in January 1958 -- it is probable that specifications will need revision to attain acceptable frame time and tracking capacity -- Group 61, 67, and 68 efforts in this study will be coordinated in a series of meetings of the three Group Leaders starting 16 December.

2. Salary Review

Everett reported that all Division VI data had been delivered to the Director's Office on time.

3. Air Traffic Control

Everett outlined briefly the results of the recent visit of General Quesada accompanied by General Estes, Colonel Shiely, and Messrs. Anast, Lyman, Greene, and McIntyre to discuss Air Traffic Control and its relationship to the Air Defense system -- Weiser discussed with the visitors several approaches to an Air Traffic Control study which could be made by Lincoln using 10 to 30 people -- Overhage pointed out that any larger study would cut into Lincoln's Air Defense effort -- discussion of experimental facilities favored ESS over CCS and recognized that ESS availability would become easier in 1959.

4. Visitors

Everett discussed tentative plans for a visit to Division VI 17 December by Professor Radford.
