ACTION

1. Air Defense Objectives

Group 68 is starting a study of future air defense objectives, with Bill Holden the first staff member assigned to this. Will be considered as a systems problem. The Group is seeking sources of intelligence information on which to base its study

2. MITRE

Everett reviewed his understanding of the current situation. There is little definite information beyond Dr. Overhage's memo of August 7.

3. Staff Requisitions

Proctor summarized the current ADSID Reserve hiring and open requisitions. Everett stated his understanding that the ceiling is now off.

Everett requested the Group Leaders to turn in requisitions to cover their anticipated needs for the next three months.

4. Union Negotiations

Papian announced that the Labor Relations Board completed the preliminary hearings and has set September 10 for the election.

5. Building 10 Program

Goodenough and Papian summarized their discussion with Gordon Brown on the Building 10 Program. Considerable revision is clearly necessary, but the purchase order will be renewed through the present fiscal year to allow time for reorganization.
