ACTION

1. IBM School

Morriss reported IBM plans to discontinue the programming school in Lexington -- Group Leaders foresaw no Lincoln Laboratory problem in this discontinuance.

2. XD-1

Canty showed a tabulation illustrating difficulties in XD-1 time allocation -- he distributed copies of a tabulation for the period February 17-March 31 which divided time into good, fair, and poor, from the standpoint of programmer working hours -- he also distributed copies of the XD-1 schedule for week of 2 March.

Everett requested that the problems of XD-1 time allocation be discussed at a smaller meeting with appropriate Group Leaders

3. FY '58 Budget

Proctor tabulated FY '58 extraordinary funds budget position on the blackboard -- Everett summarized the total picture and discussed the needs of individual Groups including replacement Ozalid machine for Group 60 and an electron microscope for Group 63.

4. 704 Time

Everett reviewed the over-all picture on 704 time indicating the need for long term block allocation of time by Divisions, and a detailed allocation similar to that used on Whirlwind and MTC -- present forecasts of 704 computer time requirements exceed the 147 hours per week available -- Farr reported that detailed estimates for all divisions have been submitted to Lone and charts will be ready this afternoon.

Everett called a meeting for 24 February at 3 P.M. with Division VI Group Leaders concerned.

ACTION

5. ADSID

Everett announced the change of name from ADSMO to ADSID (Air Defense System Integration Division) -- General Bergquist has been appointed head of ADSID and assigned to Lexington. Everett also reported on several meetings with General Bergquist including a 22 February meeting to assist ADSID in preparation of a document for a high level presentation setting forth the responsibilities and organization of a system integration activity. He indicated that Lincoln participation in system integration is pending decisions in Cambridge.
