Iconography of Church as follows:

Altar window is Resurrection window  
Narthex window a Te Deum, a truly triumphant  
Composition.

Aisle windows, medallion type in two  
divisions, Prophecy & Fulfillment, and should  
be as far as possible chronological.  
The Christy windows are in three  
divisions; and were planned as grilles  
with figures of the Prophets and outstanding  
characters of the Old and New Testament.

Not fixed on characters of the window  
but my client is anxious that as far  
as possible the color scheme of the  
church be reinforced, that the window  
shall be a very warm window, rather  
than a cool one.

Find another figure as a foil to David in  
place of St. George. Mr. Council suggested  
Gideon

Handle with care scale of figures in different Councils.

(Designs for inscriptions to be found in letter  
files)

May 22

Use figure of Edward VI, who compiled the Prayer Book, instead of David  
The kneeling figures in outside panel may stay the same way unless we hear further.  
Symbol of four Evangelists may stay the same unless we hear further.

David scroll should have quotation from the Te Deum.

King Edward scroll should have quotation from Te Deum.

Coloring sketch. Keep the blues and greens. Submit to a generally warm scheme.
