General Information Suggestion made that there should be at least two figures. of which St. Paul should be the principal one. The subject should be "St. Paul Preaching", or as suggested before, "The Address on Mars Hill, or "Before King Agrippa" might be used. Avoid Barnabas, John, Mark, Timothy, Apollos, Stephen, Luke, Silas, and Titus as they will probably be used in the transept clerestory windows.

Feb. 8. "using single figures of St. Paul and King Agrippa in the upper parts of the lancets, while the base panels could contain typical scenes or instances done in the medallion manner, similar to the bases of your aisle windows. Under the figure of St. Paul, the scene could be St. Paul preaching at Athens, and under King Agrippa, Paul appearing before that monarch."
