for \$700.00.)

Mr. Anthony writes that Father Prior wants him
(St Patrick) in a green vestment.

Mrs Frye telephoned as follows.
First instance. St Patrick would wear an
all with appurts. (colored ones). (embroidered)
Over that a cope with a mitre, and his
pastoral staff and gloves with a little
shamrock on the right hand one, and those
funny little shoes you use.

Second instance. When he is celebrating the
Eucharist. He would wear with the all
and dalmatic, tunicle (stole etc) over that
the chasuble.

In no instance should he wear the chasuble
and dalmatic with the cope.

Sulphur Arthur wrote from Goodhue office.
Figure heights have not been determined yet.
They are anywhere from 4'6" to 5'-0 in height.

Single lancet window without tracery.
To contain memorial inscription but no ventilator.
To contain best quality of antique glass throughout.

Photographs of cartoons to be submitted to Father Heffernan and to B.G. Goodhue architect.
Father Heffernan to send inscription later.

Told Mr. Goodhue to have inserted in the contract the date on which window is to be delivered and set.

Dec. 12, 1917. B.G. Goodhue writes that the memorial inscription is "In memory of Ann McInerney." Also writes that the following Latin texts may be used entirely or in suitable parts:
"Statuit ei Dominus testamentum pacis, et principem fecit eum".
"Ecce Sacerdos magnus, qui in diebus suis placuit Deo."
"Tu es Sacerdos in aeternum, secundum ordinem Melchisedech Alleluia."
Mr. Connick replied, "In such a small window I doubt if more than one text could be used."
