When Mrs. Murphy received the sketches she called our attention to the fact that in the transparencies previously sent she prefered the Gardner, Me. window in which the blue color predominated and she felt that the red band in the design sent some what confused the tone of the window.

The figures of St. Ann and St. Francis she likes but is not so well pleased with the Virgin Mary and Our Lord. She liked the character of pose better that was used in the Gardner. Maine, window.

The face of St. Thomas she does not care for and she does not think the figure of St. John net beautiful enough. Windows are very small and the architect feels that perhaps there is too much scale in the design. A certain amount of simplification might prove better in the final results.
