General Information I suggested that the divisions of the window be more nearly square than Bangs intended on account of the flanks of the quilt. Mrs Williams thinks Mr Connick's judgment better than hers, but to her one of the most attractive features of the window is the little circular design around the corners of the divisions. Personally she much prefers this variation to perfectly straight lines
