The building is in the open country and is flooded with light.
With the lower tier of the windows left clear, the two and a half tiers of
transoms should be obscure and with enough interest and color to serve in
the same relationship as to those in the University Club without being
"Solid".
"I think it is also important that the simple glazing be practically the
same in all three divisions, as you have suggested in your plans, - the
enrichment in the upper windows to be developed in medallions and oblong
shapes, similar to the windows in the Children's Hospital, Cincinnati.
