General Information Symbol of Saint Luke in Centre, and Pomegranate and
rubies in surrounding pieces. symbol of the Church, with plenty of fine
blues and rubies., green,* gold and some orange - the blue very pure.

Study the design further in the cartoons - possibly eliminating some
of the pomegranates.

We are planning to use a fairly wide outside border of rather dark
color, which will tend to cut down the apparent size of the opening.
Mr. Study has suggested a barring arrangement as follows: - Two heavy
ones across the petals, and two slightly lighter ones up and down,
if this does not create too much of a radiation of lines from the
center.
