General Information Rose Window - "The only symbolism in this window should be the descending dove in the center with the rays in the cross reversed from the background of the circle. This will help to simplify the design."

"This window to be featured with a sun-burst design in the cross radiating from a dove placed in the quatrefoil and the background to reverse, giving a contrast and a setting for the main architecture of the window. This would be more or less a treatment of color rather than design, with very little symbolism outside of the dove in the center".
