General Information No symbolical figure work is desired in the windows; we
have in mind the effect of glass mosaic.
The side Sanctuary windows open into a 20 foot alley, with buildings about
8 stories high on the opposite side. With the exception of the front
elevation, none of the windows will be in the direct sunlight, and for this
reason, we believe that these windows should be treated in rather light
colors.

The detail of the sash will be changed somewhat and will allow only 1/2"
between the storm glass and the stained glass.
