**IMPORTANT:** The temporary windows in the new Cathedral are leaking quite badly in many places due to probably two causes - improper and lack of thorough cementing of glass in the zinc comes, and also the fact that the Cathedral has a very high, exposed position, and no doubt the wind forces a great deal of water through. Be sure to make the permanent windows thoroughly water-tight.
