There are six windows altogether in the auditorium and have north and south facings. Balance of windows might be glazed with simple kind of glass to harmonize with the memorial window. Walls of auditorium will probably be in a textured plastic paint finished with a slightly rough cast, and will probably be in old ivory, and the ceiling will be rich in polychrome treatment. The glass for the others will perhaps be glazed in Spokane.
Upright Division at center of arch must remain.
