General Information Note from Cram's letter, Jan. 18, 1927 - "The intermediate T sections which are not shown on our drawing are to be furnished by you. These T sections are to be so placed that the stem projects toward the outside of the window, with the flange acting as a weather-stop on the inside. The full size drawing of the T sections which were sent to you will indicate to you the desired arrangement."

1/2" square bars to be used instead of round bars.

Text for bases of window - "A new commandment I give unto you that ye love one another as I have loved you." (St. John 13-34).
