General Information Under the balconies there are only two small shields, and two larger ones to be done. The two larger ones are to be Saint Philip and Saint Bartholomew. Maxx processed with material for the Maxx sem Maxx the names of the two Maxx. The smaller ones are to be St. Agatha and Saint Mary of Cleophas (or James).

According to our letter of July eleventh, 1930, these four might be done for anywhere from \$195.00 up. The four should not cost more than \$225.00. The four can be done together, and no particular time limit.

In an old list of Apostles we have the first two (Philip and Bartholomew) made for
Pierre la Rose. Saint Philip, Vert, a basket with two loaves or.
Saint Bartholomew - Barry of six, gules and or, a flaying knife in pale argent

For Saint Agatha we have used the pincers with the breasts on a platter, and also the
shears.

Saint Mary Cleophas (or James) - Husenbeth gives her as seated with her four sons
about her, bearing the following emblems. Saint Jude - a boat; Saint James -
a mill or palm branch. Saint Simeon - a fish. Saint Joseph Barsabas - a cup, bowl,
three stones, or loaves.
