Apr. 13, 1943. Sent touched up design: "I have added the symbol of the burning bush, which I think can be very significantly rendered in the full size drawings and the actual glass. I shall keep in mind your thought for a younger Child, although you will recall the traditional practice of suggesting in Him something of the maturity, even in infancy, of the One Who was to bear the burden of the world. This is also symbolized in the globe surmounted by the cross, which He holds."
