Extract from Mr. Mills letter of March 12, 1931 - "The narthex windows are approved and also the openings shown for the windows except that in each aperture it is suggested that there should be one or more spaces of clear glass at the level of the eye. This has been found very desirable in connection with glass in other parts of the new construction".

C.J.C. replied Mar. 14. - "In your next to the last paragraph you speak of the narthex windows "and also the openings shown for the windows". Here I think you mean the doors; and so we will arrange to have one or more clear spaces of glass at the level of the eye."
