"The rough sketch marked 'X' shows the general revised layout except that at the north end it is proposed to put a fireplace with bookcases on either side of it, and bookcases on either side of the window at the south end. It is thought to make the south window one in honor of one of the generous benefactresses of the hospital, and it will have noted on it, 'This room is dedicated to Elisabeth Severance Prentiss'. This window would be the main feature of the room and the other four windows, it was thought, (over)

Revised plan shows south window centered in an interior wall, receiving its light from the exterior window about three feet away, slightly off center in the exterior wall.
