Mr. Whitehouse wrote (July 22, 1931) - "The chapel windows can be slightly different in treatment than the other windows, and I will leave this entirely up to your organization to make the suggestions."

The two large windows of the chapel are as follows: - Daylight opening 9 1/2" x 44 1/8"; Regular glass opening 10 3/16" x 44 13/16". These are stock pattern steel casement sash.

*This price was increased from \$100. to \$150 "To enable us to improve these windows and make them richer"- from Whitehouse.

Sent photographs of the two larger chapel windows to Whitehouse, Jan. 4, 1932, with the following note: "You will notice that we have developed the enrichment in both instances.The little figures of the Archangels in the Chapel Window will give a colorful note there. These Archangels of Peace and Victory (or Justice) Gabriel and Michael, bear their symbols the Lily and the Flaming Sword." (Michael, - Prince of the Heavenly Hosts, and Gabriel, the Messenger of Divine Revelation.)
