Description of Design: 1/18/33: "The first lancet of this window contains the figure of Saint Paul, "Sower of Spiritual Seed", with his symbols, the sword, scroll and three fountains, and in the second lancet is the Sower from the Parable (S.Matt.13:3). Below Saint Paul are two medallions representing his conversion (Acts 9:3) and preaching to the Athenians (Acts 17:21). In the other lancet the Sower is first scattering the seed and then, in the upper medallion, harvesting the crops. Angels of prayer and praise in the tracery reflect the colors of the figures below: Blue for heavenly truth and fidelity, and Green for hope in immortality."
