General Information Decoration.
The photograph of the coat of arms of Kenyon is clipped to the sketch layout. (This was sent us by P.H. Taylor, Secretary). The chief is purple; the crozier gold, and the book natural colors with black motto: the base is black; crosses, silver; chevron, gold. As the photograph fails to render the dots on the chevron indicating gold, this has been dotted in pencil.

Description sent with sketch: "The boys and the birds are blue. The shield is of course in heraldic color, and the leaves are gold and blue-green. Light touches of brilliant orange accent the contours of the figures, birds and shields." May 24, 1932. The boyhood of Philander Chase's own time is suggested in somewhat playful fashion.
