General Information C.J.C.'s suggestion is a very simple treatment, with a  
figure in the center - perhaps of an angel - and the field something the  
North Andover.

It is a three-lancet window - probably gothic head, but we are not sure.  
The central lancet is 4'8" wide and 16 1/4" high, plus a ventilator at  
the bottom 2'8" high. The side lancets are 14' high and 3'6" wide,  
plus ventilators the same height as the middle one.
