General Information Brick Church built by Mr. Murphy in 1917. Filled with Zettler windows. Much more of the antique flavor than the usual Munich glass. There are 4 Sacristy groups, which now only have protection glass. Mr. Murphy has suggested a fairly simple leaded glass design to the priest, who seemed receptive to the idea, but made no promises or gave any ideas of treatment.
