General Information Description of design. "This design presents the theme of  
Our Lord's Transfiguration, related symbolically to the mystery of the Holy  
Eucharist, and recognizing in design the three-fold architectural division.  
The figure of St. Peter kneels in the center below that of the Savior.  
Below the apparition of Moses at the left kneels Saint James, while Elias  
and Saint John are at the right.  
This design is developed to compliment and harmonize with the typical  
aisle windows, and at the same time to reflect its position of special  
importance in a richer and more monumental treatment."
